Bounce House Use in Valley Park

The City of Hermosa Beach desires to provide safe parks and recreational opportunities for all residents and visitors. The recreation division is charge with ensuring that park patrons and user groups comply with reasonable standards that promote safety and the reasonable enjoyment of Hermosa Beach's public parks.

The following policy applies to all individuals and groups that make use of the bounce house or similar apparatus at Hermosa Beach Valley Park. Users of bounce houses or other similar apparatus are subject to the following conditions and requirements:

1. Users must first obtain a Park Reservation for the use of Valley Park and inform Recreation Staff a bounce house will be used as part of the event.
2. Users must abide by all conditions, rules and disclaimers as noted in this policy, on the Park Reservation Form and the City of Hermosa Beach Municipal Code.
3. Bounce companies must be rented from a company that has liability insurance on file with the City. Companies renting bounce houses must submit current and valid evidence of general and automobile liability insurance of not less than \$1 million Combined Single Limit, from a company authorized to transact the business of insurance in the State of California. The insurance company must have an AM Best Rating of not less than B 6. The bounce house company must provide an original endorsement to the general liability policy which contains the exact language: *"The City of Hermosa Beach and its elected appointed boards, officers, agents and employees are additional insured under policy number ____."*
4. Bounce house will only be set up by qualified representatives of the bounce house rental company in compliance with manufacturer specifications.
5. Bounce house users will be responsible for providing a generator for inflation of the bounce house. The City does not provide electricity. The generator will be one notes as "quiet" and not generate noise in excess of City standards. The generator should be placed a safe distance from the bounce house and electrical chords covered to prevent tripping hazards.
6. All bounce houses and generators will be placed in the designated "Amphitheater" area only!
7. The bounce houses may not have dimensions larger than 20 ft. X 20 ft.
8. Bounce houses are not allowed in City parks overnight.
9. Bounce houses must be free standing and weighted. Stakes are prohibited in City parks. Bounce houses must not be tied or tethered to trees, tables and park amenities.
10. Bounce house users must provide adequate supervision so that the use is in compliance with manufacturer's recommendations and reflects safe levels of operation.
11. The park user is responsible for all damaged caused by their use of the park or the bounce house.
12. No vehicle is allowed in City parks, on turf or on walkways.
13. The City is not responsible for any damage to the bounce house.
