

Park Reservations: Hermosa Beach Residents Only

Park Reservations: Valley Park & South Park

Reservations will be made on a first come first serve basis for residents of Hermosa Beach only. Valid ID is required to be shown when making a park reservation. Reservations are made at the Community Center, 710 Pier Avenue, Hermosa Beach.

The Community Resources Department will take a maximum of two reservations on each available calendar day. Park reservations must be made in person during regular business hours (Monday-Thursday from 7am-6pm) at the Community Center.

One bounce house per day is permitted in the amphitheatre at Valley Park. You must have a park reservation and proof of insurance naming the City of Hermosa Beach as additionally insured when requesting a bounce house. The bounce house must be rented from one of the pre-approved companies and the contract must be in the same name as the name of the resident with the park reservation. The approved bounce house companies are listed below.

Reservations will be made for parties of 50 or fewer with four tables maximum.

Absolutely no alcohol is permitted at the Park.

The areas of the parks without a reservation are open to the public (residents and non-residents) on a first come first serve basis.

In order to use the fire pit at Valley Park, you must make a park reservation and then obtain a Fire Permit at the Fire Department (310-318-0326).

As of July 1, 2008 the following fees are effective:

- \$60.00: Park Reservation
(Includes \$20.00 application fee and a 4 hour time slot with 4 tables)
- \$25.00: Bounce House Fee
- \$87.00: Fire Permit Fee:
